Scope of the review

Allnex Belgium nv performed an LCA study to:

- Comprehensively define the environmental impacts over a cradle-to-gate life cycle study for the product system studied;
- Provide an accurate analysis of the contribution of the different life cycle stages to each environmental impact.

The role of Vinçotte was to independently review the LCA study.

The review of the LCA was performed according to the rules set out in the international standards ISO 14044 and ISO 14040 and comprised a review of:

- Conformity of the LCA-study to ISO 14040 and ISO 14044;
- The LCA-project report;
- The LCA-model;
- The representativeness of the primary data.

To carry out our review assignment, we declare that:

- Sufficient knowledge has been acquired of the SETAQUA waterborne acrylic emulsions and resins production process;
- Vinçotte was not involved in performing the LCA-study;
